
Duval County Florida Five-Year Trend in Severe Maternal Morbidity Rates per 1,000 Live Births by Race



During the five-year observational period, the Black Severe Maternal Morbidity (SMM) rate increased by 2.3 per 1,000 live births each year while the White SMM rate increase by 1.6. On average, the annual occurrences of SMM is 44% higher among Black mothers. Controlling for year, (the value of y when x is equal to 0), 76% higher. This difference accounts for unspecified factors that contributed to the higher SMM prevalence among Black mothers.
